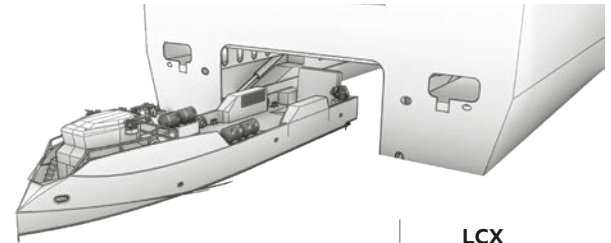
A major asset to Naval Forces

With a high level of seaworthiness and maneuverability, designed with a 360° command bridge, the LCX can accommodate anti-submarine and mine warfare detachments to support **reconnaissance, identification and threat neutralisation**. The LCX is proposed in 23 metres (Makassar compatible) or 29 metres (NATO compatible) but other configurations are available on demand.
