1856
Creation of FCM (Forges et Chantiers de la Méditerranée).



1859
The first steam-powered, propeller-driven armored frigate is built.

1881
The French Navy's first submarine, *Le Gymnote*, is built.

1960
Partnership with German firm Martin, which specializes in grates for waste combustion.

1966
FCM is acquired by Herlicq Group and becomes CNIM.



1968
Licensing deal with Walter, a German industrial boiler specialist, and creation of "Boilers" division.

1917
The first French tanks are built.

1947
Innovation in boilers and funnels to carry exhaust from ships.

1950
Construction of 8,300- to 13,000-ton cargo ships and ocean liners.

1970
Cooperation agreements with two divisions of General Electric for marine and industrial turbines.

— First role as operator of energy-from-waste plants.
— Construction of boiler for Thémis solar power plant.



1961



— Construction of first missile launch tubes in the nuclear submarines in the *Force Océanique Stratégique* (Strategic Oceanic Force).
— Marketing of LNG carriers, container ships and drilling platforms.

First move into environment business: Energy-from-waste plants (Issy-les-Moulineaux, France).

Construction of first escalator for RATP, the Paris public transport operator.

Shipbuilding activities are discontinued after the industry is nationalized by the French Government.

Marketing of spent nuclear fuel unloading machines.

Investment in workshop dedicated to composite materials.

Evaporators for desalination plants in Abu Dhabi, Algeria, Saudi Arabia, Iraq and Libya.

1975
First energy-from-waste plant outside France (Moscow, Russia).



1980
Creation of subsidiary in Hong Kong.

1983
Sale of motorized floating bridge to Switzerland, Malaysia and Italy.

1987
Creation of subsidiary in the United Kingdom with Martin.

1989-1990
Acquisition of Babcock Entreprises and Wanson (industrial boilers for Europe and Africa).

First time as lead for a consortium with Finland's Ahlström for circulating fluidized bed boilers.

1995
Creation of EGIDE for flue gas treatment.

Acquisition of flue gas treatment specialist LAB SA.
